



REMINDER RE: Flagperson Apparel

Alberta Transportation Flagperson Apparel

- The colour of the coveralls and vests is fluorescent yellow-green with silver reflective striping. The striping must be a minimum of 50 mm wide and is sewn onto a wide red-orange background material.
- Flagpersons will also wear fluorescent headgear, and will be equipped with the traffic control paddles specified in the latest edition of Alberta Infrastructure and Transportation's Traffic Accommodation in Work Zones manual.
- Where there is foreseeable risk of injury to a worker's head, flagpersons shall wear fluorescent orange protective hardhats meeting the requirements of CSA Standard Z94.1-92. Where **no foreseeable risk** of head injury exists, flagpersons will be permitted to wear any type of fluorescent orange headgear.
- The lime yellow coveralls and vests differentiate the flagperson from the rest of the construction crew, so motorists recognize them, and know that they should follow their directions.



Please remind your site crews that yellow-green coveralls and vests are to be worn ONLY by flagpersons and ONLY for the purpose of traffic accommodation.
