<b>TITLE</b>	Towing
<b>GENERAL</b>	Protecting workers from injuries associated with towing operations
<b>APPLICATION</b>	Towing vehicles or equipment requires proper training and tools
<b>PROTECTIVE MECHANISMS</b>	Safe work procedure PPE Warning signals and flags Manufacturers specifications Alberta Safety Act ERP (Emergency Response Plan)
<b>SELECTION AND USE</b>	As per safe work procedure
<b>SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITY</b>	To facilitate and/or provide proper instruction to their workers on protection requirements and training
<b>WORKER RESPONSIBILITY</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Ensure warning devices are in place</li><li>2. Ensure you are conversant with proper hand signals</li><li>3. DO not stand between vehicles</li><li>4. Ensure equipment is in good condition</li><li>5. Wear proper PPE (High visibility vests, gloves, etc.)</li><li>6. Follow appropriate hooking and load securing practices.</li></ol>
